See below. ■ Step 5- Show up to class on the first day! <p>NOTE: If you are unable to register for the course (i.e. your registration date is after the first day of class or the class/waitlist is full), you can still show up on the first day of class and try to add. If there are spots open, you will be given an add code. Any students who do not show up to the first day of class will be dropped from the course. If you have an emergency that will prohibit you from attending the first day of class, notify us ASAP so that you are not dropped.</p>			
FEES:	The Moreno Valley College fee is \$63.00/\$79.00 (broken down as follows: \$46 unit fee; \$15/\$18 Student Health Fee and \$2/\$15 Student Services fee). If you have the BOG-Waiver [financial aid], all you pay is \$33/\$30 for the student health fee and student service fee. The student service fee can be waived by contacting the Students Activities Center. The fee for the course is payable via WebAdvisor upon course enrollment.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:	Good pair of running shoes; running and compression shorts; when needed, cold weather gear (i.e. gloves, beanie, and sweat pants); water bottle or hydration back pack; any medication taken (i.e. inhaler); when needed, a headlamp light (mandatory for winter session).			
PREREQUISITE:	Interested or in the law enforcement background process to attend the basic, modular or corrections academy. This is a physically demanding course. Participants should be in good physical condition.			
DRESS CODE:	Students must wear appropriate physical conditioning attire and running shoes. Please see the course syllabus for additional information.
